

IDEAL EDIS System Requirements:

- 1) Seamlessly integrated into hospital information system so inpatient physicians can view ED notes
- 2) Intuitive, easy-to-use interface
- 3) Continuously updated patient tracking/status board (plasma screens and PCs)
- 4) Process and order status/tracking
- 5) Multiple input devices including wireless tablet PCs
- 6) Bedside charting for nurses and physicians
- 7) No or minimal downtime
- 8) Prompts docs and nurses to enter more info if LOS does not match expected LOS for diagnosis, work up or chief complaint
- 9) Customizable timed alerts
- 10) Customized view on tracking board for each area of ED
- 11) Customizable templates
- 12) Articulate text notes
- 13) Discharge instructions in English, Spanish and Polish
- 14) Prescription writer
- 15) Seamless integration with charting
- 16) Statistical reports including JCAHO log, coding summary, length of stay ect
- 17) Short learning curve
- 18) Easy access to prior records
- 19) Imports lab results into physician note
- 20) Computerized physician order entry
