

## *At Home Lovenox*

- ✓ Verify with patient which pharmacy that they fill their prescriptions at and phone that pharmacy to make sure they have the Lovenox in stock and verify what the patients insurance coverage/copay will be for the prescription. If their pharmacy doesn't carry Lovenox try contacting Beacon Pharmacy (543 West Main St., New Britain) @ 860-225-6487. Ensure the MD writes a prescription for the Lovenox
- ✓ Ask patient if they would like to have a visiting nurse come to their home to help educate them on the injection process
- ✓ If patient wants visiting nurses, complete w10 for RN services for education/instruction on Lovenox injections – indicate the dose and how often the patient will receive the medication as well as any other PMH and medications the patient is taking
- ✓ Call in referral to the visiting nurse agency the patient chooses, fax the w10 to the company and leave the original with the patients chart
- ✓ Contact the hospital pharmacy and obtain a “At home Lovenox” kit for patient which will further help the patient in the community – also if the patient is going to receive their first dose of Lovenox in the ED, take the time to educate the patient on the injection process as well

*\*\*\*\* If the patient does not want VNA care please just confirm their pharmacy has the Lovenox and provide them with the “At home” kit and educate them on the injection process in the ED*
